Prior Learning policy honors the service, experience of our nation's veterans and their dependents. SU students can reduce costs for coursework already mastered that leads to high wage in-demand cyber employment.

VETERANS Any student who attends a prep course under any chapter may attend from the date on student COE. Students are VA reimbursed for class fees receipts. Exam fees are line items and noted as included or not included in the class fee on each invoice and receipt "as noted above" No late fee penalty's or denial of access to classes or libraries, or require the student borrow additional funds chapter 31 or 33 unless student is less than 100% covered.

NON-STANDARD TERM DEFINITION SU classes are non-standard term [shorter than a standard quarter or semester]. The number of hours a student attends class is measured. Students enroll in a 520 hour program of 10 classes and 3 practical's. Students should complete 2-3 classes each year in years 1-3, and complete at least one class in years 4-7.

STUDENT ENTRANCE REQUIREMENT - In order to be admitted as a student at Security University, a student must demonstrate sufficient knowledge of the Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol (TCP/IP). TCP/IP is the language a computer uses to access the Internet. It consists of a suite of protocols designed to establish a network to provide a computer with access to the Internet. TCP/IP defines the details of how data is sent and received through networks. Sufficient knowledge of TCP/IP is essential for students to understand and address the coursework at SU. While 2 months of experience on your resume helps, there is no exact amount of time period of employment with TCP/IP required. The President of Security University and/or any board member designated by the President shall determine prior to class whether or not a student has sufficient knowledge of TCP/IP in order to be admitted into SU. The primary purpose is whether a student has the necessary foundation to succeed in the coursework offered at SU. All decisions made by the President or any board designated by the President are final.

Army/ USAF Credentialing Assistance Program

The Army Credentialing Assistance (CA) Program provides funding for voluntary off-duty courses and/or exams leading to an industry-recognized academic or vocational credential/license.

What Do I Get?

- \$2000 per fiscal year. You can use CA and TA together, but not exceed \$2000.
- Pays for classroom, online/blended plus associated exams, materials and all required fees (i.e., manuals, books, supplies, study guides, and recertification of credentials).

Eligibility:

- First Credential Plan – completed AIT, WOBC, or BOLC.
- Second Credential Plan – completed ALC, WOAC, or Captains Career Course.
- No negative/adverse action flags or HOLDS that would prevent usage of TA.

Three Credentialing Options for each Credential Plan

1. Civilian Occupation Related – you can stack certifications under your Credential Plan.
2. Academic Related – One certification per degree.
3. MOS Related – Cannot be a MOS requirement. In that case, you will use proponent funding.

Credential Eligibility:

1. Must be completed before Soldier's ETS date (watch your terminal leave).
2. Is an Army vetted vendor/school.

Checklist

- Speak to a counselor.
- Research www.cool.osd.mil/army for your credential/license requirements/eligibility. Identify Security University as vendor/school and contact them for course/exam details. Get an itemized invoice or quote emailed to you.
- Set up an account via www.armyignited.com and complete a Credential Path.
- Ensure you have an active GoArmyEd account with homeschool listed. If you are using TA, you will already have a school listed. If you do not, you will choose Credential School.
- Complete your CA funding request **AT LEAST 45 BUSINESS DAYS** prior to your start. No exceptions. The system is designed to block you requesting a date that is not at least **30 business days**.
- Once you submit your request, monitor your email and ArmyIgnitED account.
- When you have completed your credential/exam, you will have 10 days to submit your proof through ArmyIgnitED. It must be in the form of certificate, license, exam results, etc. directly from your vendor.
